

Superior Refinery Community Advisory Panel Mini-Grant Program

In an attempt to improve and enhance science and environmental education in our schools the Superior Refinery Community Advisory Panel (CAP) is sponsoring a mini-grant program for schools in Douglas County, Wisconsin.

Cash mini-grants up to \$500 may be awarded to teachers interested improving or enhancing science or environmental studies by getting their students out in the field to experience their studies in the real world outside of the classroom. Examples of projects may include investigating a specific scientific or environmental problem, visiting a specific environment being studied (wetland, river, etc.), conducting specific experiments related to classroom instruction, or taking a field trip to a location for students to learn from experts in the field (business, industry, or government agency).

Mini-grant recipients will be expected to make a presentation to the Community Advisory Panel at the June meeting describing their methodology and the results of their project if available. Recipients will be phoned prior to receiving their award for a commitment to present their project to the panel.

Eligibility: Any teacher K-12 in Douglas County with specific needs to conduct science or environmental projects outside of the school. These are meant for class projects not individual projects or research. They should address academic standards for the district and state.

Grants: \$100 to \$500 grants will be awarded in November of each year projects chosen, are expected to be completed by June of the following year, or in the same school year. A recipient is eligible for one grant.

Application: Any teacher who wishes to have a project considered for a mini-grant should complete an application form and budget and submit it to the CAP. The application must be received by October 1st. Application may be mailed to:
